



Craven Hall Dedication April 19th

Craven Hall is scheduled to be dedicated at 9:30 on Monday, April 19th. We assume that the dedication will take place beneath the big "William A Craven Hall" sign at the front of the building, but of course, nobody tells us anything...

The Academic Senate unanimously passed the following motion:

The Academic Senate makes known to President Stacy That the Senate is opposed to the dedication of Craven Hall until these concerns (e.g. McCarthyism and ethnicity and class) are addressed to the satisfaction of the Academic Senate; that a letter be written to Senator Craven requesting clarification of his remarks and inviting his presence on campus for an exchange of views
